ECONOMIC IMPACT & INVESTMENT

Since Frederick’s 2001 designation, the work of the local Main Street program resulted in:

- **967** private investment projects (**\$83 million** in investment)
- **208** public improvement projects (**\$40 million** in investment)
- **389** new businesses
- **1567** jobs created
- **63,221** volunteer hours valued at **\$1.6 million**
