Since Frederick's 2001 designation, the work of the local Main Street program resulted in:

- **967** private investment projects (**\$83 million** in investment)
- **208** public improvement projects (\$40 million in investment)
- 389 new businesses
- 1567 jobs created
- **63,221** volunteer hours valued at \$1.6 million
