3. Provide ornamental fence with screen planting between park and parking lot.

4. Reduce entrance lane width to slow vehicles coming off N. Market Street. Extend sidewalk paving into roadway as shown to provide visual que to slow traffic down into the parking lot.

5. Provide low wall with planting along street edge to create buffer between vehicles and park visitors.

6. Expand lawn area for park events.

7. Provide trees along street edge to create buffer between vehicle traffic and park.

8. Reduce curb radius at corner to expand park space and slow vehicle traffic from N. Market Street.

9. Provide pedestrian lighting throughout park and attach flower baskets to pole for seasonal interest.

10. Provide bench seating throughout park.

11. Introduce more shade trees throughout park space for more shade opportunities.

12. Existing fountain to remain, enhance the paving surrounding the fountain.

13. Provide landscape material (potential garden club planting areas) with ornamental fence along park edges to define space and provide buffer between vehicle traffic and the park.

14. Opportunity for public art display at intersection corner.

15. Better define park edge and enhance parking lot with the introduction of planting islands.
